

Instruction applications for an EU DCC (QR code) by seafarers who have been vaccinated against covid19 in the Netherlands at Port Health Services/Arbo Unie or at KLM Health Services (Schiphol Airport)

You can apply for an EU DCC (QR code) if you have been vaccinated as a seafarer in the Netherlands by a doctor from Port Health Services/Arbo Unie or from KLM Health Services. You must then fill in the attached form in which you provide your personal e-mail address. You enclose a clearly legible photo or scan of your RIVM registration card that you received during the vaccination, as well of your ID or passport. Send this form and the photos/scans to EUDCC@kvr.nl if you have been vaccinated by a doctor from Port Health Services/Arbo Unie. And if you have been vaccinated at KLM Health Services (Schiphol Airport), send an email to covid19vaccination.health@klm.com. You will then receive a QR code at the personal e-mail address you have provided. You can scan the QR code on the EU DCC and add it to the [Dutch CoronaCheck app](#)

Pay attention:

- Incorrectly completed and/or incompletely completed forms will not be processed. The same applies if no copy/scan/photo of the RIVM card and of your ID or passport has been sent.
- If you have a Dutch citizen service number (BSN), you can make an EU DCC in the Netherlands via the [Dutch CoronaCheck app](#). Or print out a paper proof on CoronaCheck.nl. The app and the website turn this into a QR code for use abroad. In this case you cannot submit an application via EUDCC@kvr.nl or covid19vaccination.health@klm.com.
- If you have not been vaccinated by a doctor from Port Health Services/Arbo Unie or KLM Health Services, you cannot request a QR code via EUDCC@kvr.nl or covid19vaccination.health@klm.com. Then contact the healthcare provider who vaccinated you. They can prepare a corona certificate for you with the correct data. See also: [Guidepost - CoronaCheck](#)
