APPLICATION FORM: EU DIGITAL COVID CERTIFICATE

If you have received a (booster) vaccination under the Netherlands COVID-19 Vaccination Programme for Seafarers, you can apply for an EU Digital COVID Certificate (EU DCC) by completing and submitting this form, including a passport copy and copies of all vaccination records of previous vaccinations against COVID-19. Upon receipt of the EUDCC, you can scan its international QR-code and add it to the <u>Dutch CoronaCheck app</u>.

In general, this optional certificate will be of most interest to EU citizens without a Dutch social security number (BSN). The certificate will only be issued only once and remains valid for one year after your vaccination date. You can only request the certificate until 3 months after your vaccination date.
